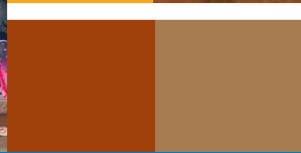

We appreciate all our members and staff at the school district for supporting us, helping us achieve success and for helping us make a positive impact like this on our school system! We appreciate you!

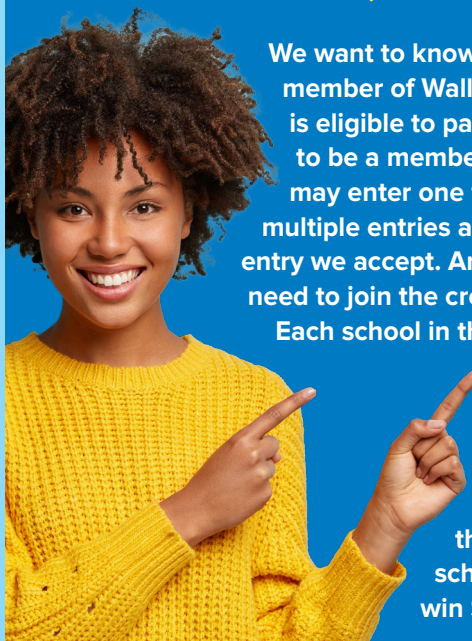
