No matter what's next in your career, whether it's college, technical school or the work force, we are here to support you. A question we get from a lot of new graduates is **“How do I develop credit if I have no credit history?”**

At WLSFCU, we offer a **Junior Visa Credit Card*** that can help students as young as age 16 start building a positive credit history and a strong credit score. **The card has a generous limit of \$500 for a first time credit cardholder.** This limit is enough to help pay for regular expenses, but not so much that a cardholder can significantly overspend and find themselves struggling to pay the balance back.

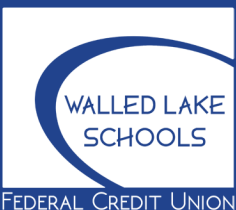
